

APWA Wisconsin Chapter Scholarship Program

This program is for **second year students** enrolled in a full-time program seeking an associate degree in Civil or Environmental Engineering, Public Administration, Public Works Management, arboriculture, heavy equipment maintenance or a related field. The **annual award is \$1,000** and the Board of Directors annually sets a limit on the number of awards to be given each year.

To be eligible for consideration, the applicant must:

- Be a full-time associate degree student who, at the time of application, has attained a second-year status in an accredited program and is seeking a degree in Civil or Environmental Engineering, Public Administration, Public Works Management or a related field.
- Be a full-time student attending an accredited technical school, college or university in the State of Wisconsin.
- Have a cumulative grade point average of not less than 3.0 on a 4.0 basis.
- Be sponsored by a current member of the Wisconsin Chapter of APWA.
- Submit a completed copy of the application, which follows this page.

<u>Application Deadline:</u> Completed applications shall be submitted to the name and address listed on the application form. All applicants must be postmarked no later than August 18, 2022. Candidates selected for scholarship(s) will be notified no later than October 1, 2022 and will be invited to attend the Chapter's Fall Conference in November.

<u>Application Review:</u> The Chairs of the Leadership and Management Committee and the Education and Scholarship Committee shall review applications and forward their recommendation to the Executive Committee for approval.

<u>Scholarship Awards:</u> Scholarship awards shall be made in the form of a check issued by the Wisconsin Chapter of the American Public Works Association. Checks shall be two-party checks issued to the student and the student's university. Scholarship awards may be used for tuition and or books.
